

CSR Donation Report

This report outlines the contributions made under the Company's Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives, in line with the activities prescribed under Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013. The donations were extended towards education, healthcare, hunger eradication, and community welfare, ensuring meaningful and sustainable social impact.

Part I – Eradicating Hunger, Poverty, and Malnutrition (Schedule VII (i))

In furtherance of the CSR objectives, the following contributions were made:

- Essential groceries, including rice, oil, and other kirana items, were provided to a trust supporting differently-abled children and their families.
- Clothes and snacks were distributed at a temple to extend welfare support to underprivileged sections of society.
- Toys were donated to a charitable foundation working for the welfare of visually impaired and cancer-affected individuals, to bring joy and comfort to children.
- Lunch was arranged at a hospital for patient relatives, ensuring nourishment during long hospital stays.
- Baby food and biscuits were supplied to a childcare institution to support nutrition and well-being of young children.
- Gift hampers were distributed at community temples as a gesture of support and respect.

These initiatives collectively addressed basic needs, reduced hunger, and extended support to vulnerable groups within the community.





Part II – Educational Support (Schedule VII (ii))

To promote education and encourage creativity among children, the following initiative was undertaken:

- Educational kits and art kits were distributed at a municipal school to foster creativity, learning, and overall development among students.
